I. Call to Order

**V. Discussion of programs for 2023
A. 75th Commission Celebration**

1. The Committee selected Saturday, November 4, 2023, to hold the Commission "birthday party" and unveil the state highway historic marker. Staff will contact Home Moravian and Old Salem to discuss plans. Ideas for keynote speakers and favors were discussed.
2. The Committee selected Saturday, October 7, 2023, from 1-3 p.m. to host a landmark open house and self-guided walking tour in Old Salem. Suggested sites for the open houses included Fifth House, Ebert-Reich House, Gardens at 907 South Church Street, Home Moravian, St. Philips Moravian Church, and the Levering House. Ms. Shill will contact the property owners.
3. Staff and the Committee members divided up a list of past Commissioners to research addresses and other information.
4. The Committee requested that staff work on a Commission history illustrated timeline that can be developed into a booklet to distribute.

B. Preservation Month Activities

1. The Committee discussed a trivia night planned for Historic Preservation month in May. Ideas included a gift basket of local swag. Ms. Kromm will be working on plans and details.

VI. Creation of Work Program

The Committee agreed that the 75th anniversary activities were a sufficient work program for the time being.

Ms. Shill moved that the Committee recommend that the Commission Chair appoint Ms. Muldovan to the Committee. Second by Ms. Thacker. The vote was unanimous.
