II. COMMITTEE REPORTS

A. Historic Marker Committee

Ms. Pegram, Chair of the Marker Committee, moved that consideration of the Alta Vista marker text be continued until March 2, 2022, as the Commission just this week had received several comments on the marker text from the applicants and had not had sufficient time to consider them.

Ms. Berry asked staff to present the text for the four remaining markers: Waughtown Freedmen's School, St. Philips Moravian Church Origin 1822, Boston Cottage Co., and Tanglewood Farm. Ms. Bratland presented the text and noted three applicant-suggested changes in the St. Philips text from the draft that was distributed to the Commission prior to the meeting.

1. Removal of the apostrophes in St. Philips
2. Addition of "in and around Salem" to describe Christian outreach
3. Removal of the modern street address for the Log Church

Ms. Pegram moved that the Commission approve the four marker texts as presented by staff, including the revisions to the St. Philips text suggested by the applicant.

Ms. Stewart suggested that the loss of the street address would be detrimental to visitors who wish to locate the log church after viewing the marker. The Commission discussed the question.

Ms. Pegram offered a substitute motion that the Commission approve the four marker texts as presented by staff, including the revisions to the St. Philips text suggested by the applicant and to reflect that the log church is located on Church Street at Race Street.
