3. Presentation of the Status of Bicycle, Pedestrian, Active Mobility Programs

Matthew presented information regarding the status of bicycle and pedestrian programmatic projects throughout the city, including the following:

- Existing Safe Routes to School Program
 - Michael Hosey provided information about the bicycle education program and the development of the program to include helmet fittings and distribution in elementary schools
- \$250,000 Safe Routes to School Non-Infrastructure grant
 - Sharon Nelson inquired about the city evaluates the success of the Safe Routes to School program
- Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety Education Campaigns
 - Sharon Nelson commented about regional differences in awareness of, and compliance with, bicycle and pedestrian safety measures and laws
