I. Call to Order

Ms. Shill called the meeting to order at 3:32 PM

II. Approval of January 17, 2023 Minutes

Ms. Kromm moved that the Committee approve the January 17, 2023 minutes. Second by Ms. Thacker. Vote was unanimous.

III. Approval of February 27, 2023 Minutes

V. Discussion of Programs for 2023

A. Preservation Month Activities

1. Trivia Night

Ms. Kromm reported to the Committee that Joymongers confirmed that May 22, 2023 is available as the date for the event. Ms. Kromm is following up with the trivia MC on scoring details. Ms. McCullough will email the Committee the trivia categories, and the Committee was asked to submit trivia questions to staff via email. Ms. Kromm will solicit prizes from local historic organizations and business for the top three winners.

2. Walking Tour – October 7, 2023 from 1:00 p.m.-3:00 p.m.

Ms. Shill's reported on potential tour locations and will have sites confirmed by the next meeting. The Committee discussed possible starting locations, volunteer needs, and the self-guided tour booklet. Staff will create the booklet once the locations are confirmed.

B. 75th Commission Celebration

Ms. McCullough reported that a proposal for the use of Home Moravian Church's sanctuary and fellowship hall for November 18, 2023 was submitted to the Church's Board of Elders. The Committee discussed the format of

the program and agreed a “conversation” style of presentation would be advantageous for the event. Staff will create a list of potential people to invite to share their experiences with the Commission to bring to the next meeting. Ms. Bratland agreed to contact the State Historic Marker Committee to confirm their plans for the installation and/or unveiling of the historic marker. Staff will begin working on the program and children’s activity book for the event.

Ms. Holcomb-Pack confirmed her interest in joining the Committee, Ms. Thacker moved to recommend to the Commission Chair that Ms. Holcomb-Pack be appointed as a Committee member. Second by Ms. Kromm. Vote was unanimous.
